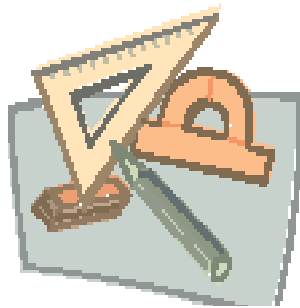

Grade 7 & 8 Numeracy Through Robotics Camp

Robotics enables students to "do" mathematics rather than study it. Robotics offers students a unit of study that implicitly demonstrates the application of math, science and technology as well as reinforce numeracy skills such as Numbers and Operations, Algebra, Geometry, Measurement, Problem Solving, Reasoning and Proof; and Communications.

After participating in the program, students will have a basic understanding of sensor based measurements, applications for angles, counted and timed events, and other computer-based math.

Robotics is a motivational tool that brings math, science and technology to life in the classroom.

The arts can play a vital role in literacy. Students can be initially engaged in reading by focusing on their comprehension and enjoyment of a given story, poem, chant, or rhyme. Fundamentally, balanced literacy revolves around two primary strands, a reading strand and a writing strand, each of which mirrors the other.

In the balanced approach, teachers are encouraged to use a balance between the traditional and the modern approach based on the needs of the students and the effectiveness of the technique employed.

Learning through the arts often enhance learning by putting into an enjoyable context important skills that may otherwise seem disconnected to a student's world. Although both the traditional and the art based courses are consistent in their objectives, they will employ different methods of delivery. The method of instruction used in this course will focus on drama, music and visual arts as a means of contextualizing core content.
