STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES

1. **ATTENDANCE:** Two (2) significant lates will be treated as one (1) absence. After three (3) absences in a two week session of Mathematics or Literacy, a student may be asked to withdraw from the course and **no** report card evaluation will be given. Please call the High School's attendance line before 8:30 a.m. each day for absences.
2. **LOANED MATERIALS:** Any textbooks, novels or other materials borrowed are to be returned in good condition or replaced if lost or damaged beyond repair. A nominal fee of **\$10** will be charged for replacement.
3. **CAFETERIA FACILITIES:** Use of the cafeteria during breaks is a privilege. Any student causing a disturbance or undue mess will make reparation and have their cafeteria privileges suspended. They will remain with their teacher during all subsequent breaks.
4. **BEHAVIOUR:** Students enrolled in Summer School must make every effort to complete both work in class and homework assigned to them. Any lost time and/or assignments must be reconciled with their classroom teacher. Students must be respectful of their teachers, fellow classmates and all other support staff on site at the designated High Schools. Students who cannot fulfill these expectations will be withdrawn from the course.
5. **SUPPORT:** Students planning to enrol in Summer School must be aware that there are **no** Special Education Resource Teachers available to assist with program modification. Every effort will be made by the classroom teacher to support and enhance the learning of each student but Identified students with Individual Education Plans **cannot** be accommodated.
6. **REPORT CARDS:** Students **not** present on the last day of each session may pick their report cards up at the Continuing Education Services, Oakville campus during the **first 2** weeks of August or they will be forwarded to your Home School.
