KIDS SAFETY FIRST AT HOME ALL BY MYSELF WORKSHOP AND THE CANADIAN RED CROSS FIRST AID FOR KIDS COURSE

For all grade 4 & 5 students that have never participated in a First Aid course or if you need a First Aid refresher this is the course for you! The Canadian Red Cross Peoplesaver Course level 3 is a fun filled workshop that will cover topics such as: what's in a first aid kit, calling EMS, emergency action steps, identifying emergencies, poisons & dangers, cuts, scrapes, wounds, impaled objects, nose bleeds, heat burns, allergies-epipens, choking and more! The At Home All By Myself Course teaches the participants how the rules change when home alone, the home alone checklist, things that the children should and should not do when home alone and much more!

ART FOR CHILDREN Pencil/Watercolour (Ages 8-12)

The emphasis of this course is to encourage imaginative expression and sharpen observational skills, as the students learn to apply an understanding of good composition, colour and perspective to their creative efforts. We will draw with pencils and graduate to watercolour paints, also introducing students to how to best prepare and preserve their tools, materials and masterpieces. *(A list of required materials will be provided prior to the first class)*

ART FOR CHILDREN - PERSPECTIVES (Ages 9+)
