Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ of Hamilton Diocese:

On this great Feast of the Holy Family, I am pleased to announce the start of the Diocesan Year of the Family; a time to rejoice in the relationships that are most profound in our lives. Jesus was born into a family and it was there that he spent his first thirty years. This is a great reminder that families are foundational to our world.

The theme of this year is Family Matters: Loving, Living, LearningGrowing in Faith. It is within family that we first experience God's love through the love of parents.
